

### **Summary:**

The John M. Coyne Recreation Center was awarded \$2,500.00 for the development of increasing programing in the city of Brooklyn. The City purchased equipment for Pickle Ball, Basketball, Corn Hole and Bocce Ball for use at the Recreation Center and the Senior Center.

We then created the Summer Field House in our Ice Arena, where the ice had been removed for the summer. This enabled Brooklyn residents to participate in Pickle Ball, Basketball and other gym activities, rain or shine, during the summer months of June and July. Bocce Ball and Corn Hole took place at the Senior Center.

- ✓ ACTIVITIES TO INCLUDE: CORNHOLE, SOCCER, FOOTBALL, VOLLEYBALL
- ✓ NO BASEBALL, SOFTBALL, LACROSSE, TENNIS, OR GOLF

# **COURT #3: PICKLEBALL**

- ✓ GAMES TO 11
- ✓ BEST 2 OF 3 NOT PERMITTED IF PEOPLE ARE WAITING FOR A COURT
- ✓ SINGLES OR DOUBLES PLAY IS PERMITTED.
